Food Services

Polyclinic

The Polyclinic at the CSG is equivalent to a walk-in clinic. The following services are provided: triage, reception. Administration, private examinations, physiotherapy, massage, bandage applications, a pharmacy and an infirmary.

- * All athletes must be accompanied by a coach, manager or mission staff for your first trip.
- * Accreditation is required
- * Medical services also provided at venues

Equipment Storage

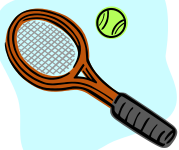
Sporting Equipment must be stored in a designated team storage facility. For more info, contact your mission staff.
