Nomination Criteria & Procedure

Nomination Year:

Award nominations are considered for an outstanding performance or series of performances from November 1, 2018-December 31, 2019

Who May Nominate:

Sport governing bodies, community sport and recreation associations, and other related clubs, groups, organizations, or individuals that are active for Sport Yukon. If the sport governing body does not submit the nomination they will be contacted to determine their degree of support for the nomination.

Nominees:

Open to athletic teams who make their primary home in the Yukon and are members in good standing with their associated sport governing body. Athletes who live temporarily in other provinces for training or education purposes are products of our territorial sport development system, are also eligible for nomination, as are athletes who originally came from other provinces, provided their primary residence is declared as being in the Yukon.

Team Criteria:

A number of individual athletes associated together in the same event. Athletes must compete as a team and cannot compete in individual categories in the same sport.
